Giving Suggestions



"I want to start giving more, but I just don't think I can. How can I start giving more regularly?"

Have you ever said this to yourself? Many of us have. How can we start moving forward when we sense God's leadership and guidance? We want to offer a few introductory guiding thoughts here.

1. Pray and Read

It all starts with getting in touch with Jesus and what He says about our hearts, giving, and money. Matthew 6:19-34 is a good place to start. As you pray and read, ask God to show you the fears and hangups you have. One at a time, turn those over to Jesus, and ask Him to replace that fear or hangup with something else. How do you feel now? How is He asking you to move forward?

2. Budget

Budgeting is key to the process of managing God's money well. A lot of questions can arise: are all of our expenses aligned with what He wants for us now? Practically, what about paying off the debt I have? What if I am living on a loan? What about...?

3. Plan

It's easier to give when we plan head. For example, hearing someone talking about giving every week at Ethnos, and thinking to yourself "oh yea, I need to give," will not take you very far. However, if you plan it out, you'll be much more successful. What if you told yourself today that you will give:

- a. Starting in 30 days (to get some budget items in order first)
- b. After every paycheck comes in, as your first "bill"
- c. At a certain percentage
